



School Improvement Plan

Weston High School is a diverse school of choice providing innovative learning opportunities that prepares students for college, career and life. Weston focuses on project/problem-based learning (PBL), positive behavior intervention supports (PBIS), contemporary grading practices and multi-tiered systems of support for our students' success.

Weston High School staff addresses the whole child through numerous approaches including Trauma-Informed Practices, Restorative Practices, Staff/Student intentional relationship building, mental health and substance abuse wrap-around services, weekly whole-school Community Meetings, Intervention/Remediation/Enrichment period, school clubs, Guest Career Speakers, and Monthly Awards/Rewards for attendance and academics.

Our focus this year is on: instructional improvement PBL; cultural improvement through PBIS, Trauma-Informed Practices and Restorative Practices; closing the gap - emphasis on attendance, credit completion, and progress monitoring through a variety of assessment practices; and community and family engagement through our Weston Connections program - a family and community volunteer and mentorship program.
