### Facility Use

Eagle Creek has the capacity for 32 classrooms, 30 classrooms within the building and two portable classrooms. We have 25 general education classrooms including four districtwide dual-language classrooms. The science classroom, library, music classroom, two computer labs and gymnasium (cafeteria) are available for student use throughout the day and complement core student instruction. You are invited to become an active part of our school.



### Student Assessment Result Comparisons

Students took an abbreviated version of the Washington State Smarter Balanced Assessments in fall 2021, which was required by the federal Department of Education. Due to the abbreviated nature of the assessment, there is no comparison data available. Standard state testing will resume in spring 2022.

### School Improvement Plan

For the 2021-22 School Year, Eagle Creek Elementary School's school improvement efforts will engage staff in meaningful professional development and action steps to increase collective efficacy in tier one instruction by:

- Embracing the Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles of variability and firm goals--flexible means.
- Implementing the PurposeFull People (*Social-Emotional-Academic-*

#### *Learning (SEAL) Curriculum)*

In addition, staff will engage in learning around reading instruction, specifically phonetic instruction through a book study of *Uncovering the Logic of English* by Denise Eide. Student success will be measured by Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) and Smarter Balanced Assessment data once baselines are collected.
