



Student Assessment Result Comparisons


3RD GRADE STATE ASSESSMENTS

Facility Use

Pioneer Elementary opened for the 2002-03 school year. This two-story elementary school houses 31 classrooms for use as kindergarten through fifth-grade classes, music, art, technology, special education and remedial programs for both math and reading. The facility also includes a multi-purpose room with a stage for use as a gymnasium, lunchroom and for assemblies and events. A 2020 Capital Levy funded the installation of a secured entryway at Pioneer. You are invited to become an active part of our school.

School Improvement Plan

Pioneer staff has focused on a multi-tiered system of support for students' academic and social/emotional needs. This is done through weekly Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) and professional development around Universal Design for Learning (UDL) along with the use of the Purposeful People curriculum. Staff has worked collaboratively to design lessons that remove barriers and allow students to access their education while offering variability within the lessons. While working on these areas, Pioneer staff has focused on being more inclusionary with students that have disabilities and teaching acceptance of all students.
