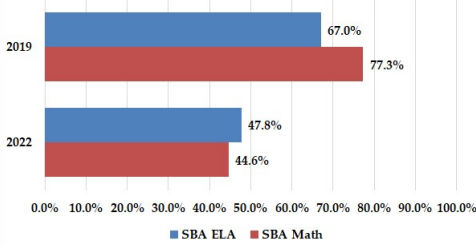

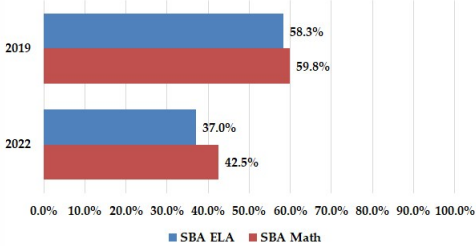
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Student Assessment Result Comparisons

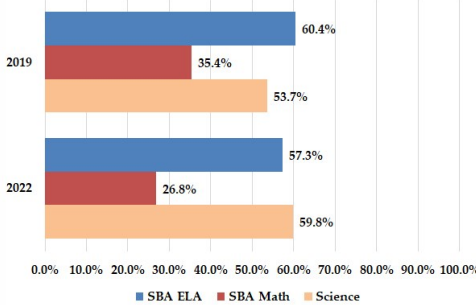
3RD GRADE STATE ASSESSMENTS

Facility Use

Presidents Elementary was project number three of a four-part bond voters approved in March 2000. The building is designed to accommodate 650 students, grades kindergarten through fifth-grade. The school is located in the "Old Town" zone of Arlington, which preserves the historic quality of the traditional town center. The building design takes this intent into account, respecting the historic Roosevelt Building and other surrounds. A 2020 Capital Levy funded the installation of a secured entryway at Presidents. School Improvement Plan

For the 2022-23 School Year, Presidents Elementary's school improvement efforts will engage staff in meaningful professional development and action steps to increase collective efficacy in tier one instruction by:

- Embracing the Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles of variability and firm goals--flexible means
- Implementing the PurposeFull People (Social-Emotional-Academic Learning) Curriculum
- Transforming instruction into diverse and accessible learning opportunities that embrace student variation

Student success will be measured by Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) and Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA) data.
