
Our School's Mission

SVLC provides a wide variety of educational opportunities and resources in a supportive learning community to parents and students who prefer an alternative to the traditional school setting.



Student Assessment Result Comparisons


3RD GRADE STATE ASSESSMENTS

School Improvement Plan

Stillaguamish Valley Learning Center (SVLC) is a K-12 school within Arlington Public Schools that operates under the Alternative Learning Experience (ALE) guidelines. SVLC students participate in the Arlington Online Program (AOP) or our SVLC Onsite Program. At SVLC, our focus this year is for our staff to engage in meaningful professional development and action steps to increase collective efficacy in tier one instruction by embracing the Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles of variability and firm goals with flexible means. We have implemented the PurposeFull People/Character Strong curriculum. Student success will be measured by increased levels of grade level proficiency, as well as, iReady scores, and standardized testing scores. Each student at SVLC is assigned to a consultant who will review progress and meet with parents/guardians each month. When needed, an intervention is created by the consultant, with input from the student and parents, to support learning both at home and on campus.
